Topic titles: Commotion in the Ocean!

English	Non chronological report writing (fact files) on underwater creatures, rhyming sea creature sentences and posters using exclamations. Developing punctuation (commas, exclamation marks, question marks and inverted commas), expanding sentences, 4 types of sentence and phonics.
Mathematics	Counting and number sequences, place value, mental calculation strategies, money and real life problems, shape space and measures, problem solving using 4 rules.
Science	Super Sea Scientists! Classification of animals and their adaptability to their environments as well as exploring habitats. Investigating salt water.
Computing	Internet safety and coding and power points on sea creatures.
History	The history of boats – Looking at how boats have changed through history. The Titanic
Geography	Water all around! Looking at local rivers and seas and oceans around the world.
Music	Composing own sea music.
Art and design	Applying washes to create sea paintings. Salt paintings. Colour mixing using primary colours to create own rainbow fish.
Physical education	Swimming and Gym.
Religious education	Judaism – looking at The Torah and the Synagogue.
Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education	Christian Values – Justice and Truthfulness.
Homework	Daily reading/sharing books with an adult. Phonemes/words. Number target. Chestnut Challenge
Events	Easter Service and trip to “The Deep” (details to be sent out nearer the time).
