Topic titles:

“Dive right in” “Force yourself” “Islam”



English

Stories by significant authors and extending narrative skills.
Journalism and play scripts including Shakespeare. Explanations and Persuasion.

Mathematics

Developing mental and written methods of calculation in all 4 operations linked with problem solving activities. Data analysis and presentation Shape and space – reflective symmetry, translations and rotations. Angles. Units of measure.

Science

Forces – Forces in action. Magnetic attraction, gravitational attraction and friction. How changes in motion that occur when forces act on an object.

Computing

Coding to simulate changes in speed and direction. Using coordinates.

Geography

Water management and coastal environments. How they are affected by erosion and people.

History

Early Islamic civilisation to include the “Islamic Golden Age”

Design and technology

Gears, pulleys and levers.

Music

Creating and developing own songs.

Art and design

Style of famous artists and different culture, including Islam. Investigating different media.

Physical education

Athletics, “outdoor and adventurous activities”. Rounders and rugby.

Religious education

Islamic belief & lifestyle.

Personal, social and emotional education

Citizenship / Personal, Social & Health Education (PSHE):
Finding out about moving on, how to cope with changes and transitions. Relating our School Council to the work of the Government. Rules for living. Makers and keepers of rules.

Homework

Daily reading; school books, weekly newspaper report (to include locating the story on a world map). Daily times tables practice or spellings work. Weekly guided reading homework. “World expert” presentation on a given river, choice of style and content. Occasional other task to support another curriculum area of current work.

SATs. Sports day. Residential trip to The Peak District. Year 6 BBQ. Leavers’ service. End of term show.
