We are a small Church of England primary school, set in a beautiful rural village, with 93 happy children on roll. We are an outward-facing school and embrace collaboration with others so that we can secure excellent achievements for all children. We continually strive to provide innovative experiences, inside and outside the classroom, that make learning fun.

Children are encouraged to become resilient in a place where it's safe to make mistakes. The Christian values of hope, peace, trust, friendship, forgiveness and respect underpin the ethos within our school.

The school has four classes. The children in our single-aged reception class enjoy a purpose built EYFS classroom with a spacious outdoor learning area. They work closely in terms of planning and ethos, with our mixed year 1/2 class. In key stage 2, we have a mixed year 3/4 class and a mixed year 5/6 class. The school is well resourced in all areas and each class has its own IT provision including interactive whiteboards, laptops and iPads.

Our school hall is used, amongst many other things, for daily collective worship, eating lunch and PE lessons. Our library is well stocked with books and also houses additional IT facilities for all classes to use. We have an attractive playground and our own sports field just a few minutes walk from the school where the children enjoy a variety of sporting activities. Our nature reserve provides the children with lots of exciting and investigative learning opportunities. Our monthly community collective worships take place at the local church which also stages annual events and productions.

We are seeking to appoint an excellent teaching assistant to work in our year 3 and 4 class. The successful candidate will support the learning of all pupils in the class, under the direction of the class teacher, but will be mainly responsible for supporting a pupil in year 4 with an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP).
