Ofsted

As you are aware, the school was subject to an Ofsted inspection on Tuesday. At the moment, the outcome must remain confidential. However, as soon as it has been published and is publically available we will share it with you.

Over the summer, a new carpet was fitted in the foyer, corridor, offices and in Willow Class. The exterior woodwork has all been repainted and the children's toilets have been re-decorated too. Now that the children have been back for a few weeks and their work is displayed around the school, the whole place is looking wonderful!

Events taking place next week...

Monday: Class information evening

We are very much looking forward to seeing you on **Monday 26 September** for our class information and phonics evening. This will be an opportunity for the teachers to talk to you about specific arrangements and procedures in their classes. There will be two identical sessions during the evening so that if you have two children in two different classes you can attend both. The first session will run from 6.00–6.30pm, the second from 6.30-7.00pm. Mrs Scarbro will be delivering two phonics information sessions for all parents of children in Maple although all other parents are welcome to attend if they would like to find out more about the teaching of phonics in school.

• Wednesday: Online safety day

As you know, our online safety day takes place on **Wednesday 28 September**. Dan Hawbrook from the Lincolnshire Safeguarding Children Board will work with all of the children during the school day. He will also run two parent information sessions at **3pm** then again at **5pm**. These sessions will last about 45 minutes. Please do attend one of the parent sessions if you can (whichever is most convenient for you) as you will be provided with important information and advice about keeping your child/ren safe when using the internet. The parent sessions are open to anyone interested in finding out more about online safety so please invite other family members or neighbours who may wish to come along.

• Friday: Macmillan Coffee Morning

Please come along to our Macmillan Coffee Morning on Friday 30 September in our school hall between 9.00am and 10.30am. During the morning, for a donation to the charity, you are very welcome to have a cup of coffee and a bit of cake or a biscuit in the hall as well as spending some time in the classrooms with the children (without your hot drink!). The children will be treated to a drink of juice and a biscuit at playtime so if you would like to send your child with a monetary donation please do although please don't feel obliged. All children will receive a drink and biscuit regardless of whether or not they have brought some money to school. In order for this to be a success, we need donations of real coffee, cakes and biscuits. Please bring donations into school on Thursday 29 September (the day before).
