Mathematics	Continuation of work with all four operations. Data analysis, negative numbers, inverse operations, algebra, Roman numerals, ratio and proportion, time and timetables
Science	Changing materials and properties of materials
Computing	Using the internet to find information. Using spreadsheets as a tool to help organise data.
Geography	Key Skills related to history.
History	Significant turning points in British history: Britain since 1930 including changes to have affected our village. The second world war.
Design and technology	Levers and stable structures.
Music	Composition using chord sequences.
Art and design	Styles of famous artists. Working and combining media to achieve different effects. 3D modelling.
Physical education	Athletics. Football.
Religious education	Religious books.
Personal, social and emotional education	Decision making. “Good to be me” Restorative approaches. Circle Time: Airing and dealing with current concerns
Homework	Daily reading; school books, weekly news report (to include locating the story on a map of Britain) “World expert” presentation on an artist or composer. Own choice of style and content. Weekly guided reading task. Occasional other task to support another curriculum area of current work. Mixed tables tests in term 3. Spelling tests in term 4.
