English	Story writing and different genres. Biography and autobiography. Poetry Focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar. Chronological and non-chronological reports. Speaking and listening in for different purposes.
Mathematics	Continuation of work with all four operations and problem solving including money. Fractions, decimals & percentages. Algebra and number patterns. Estimating and rounding.
Science	Light and sound. Electricity.
Computing	Coding. Using ICT as a tool for gathering, organising and presenting information.
Geography	How physical environments influence human activity. Linked with History.
History	Ancient Greece: Culture, cooking, architecture and art.
Design and technology	Periscopes
Music	Singing in parts. Using rhythmic, cyclic patterns.
Art and design	Find out about the styles of famous artists. Collage and 3D modelling.
Physical education	Swimming, invasion games, gymnastics.
Religious education	Religious leaders. Buddhism.
French	Going to school, and Enjoy your meal.
Personal, social and emotional education	Self esteem and friendship. Circle Time: Airing and dealing with current concerns
Homework	Daily reading; school books, weekly news report (to include locating the story on a map of the world) Daily times tables practice (weekly tests in terms 1, 3 and 5) Spellings to work on with weekly tests in terms 2, 4 and 6. “World expert” presentation on an Ancient Greek god, goddess or monster. Own choice of style and content. Occasional other task to support another curriculum area of current work.
