



Kirkby on Bain CE primary school is a small, rural school with 95 pupils currently on roll. We pride ourselves on our family ethos, strong moral purpose, distinctive Christian nature and outward-facing approach. Our school is organised into four classes: Maple (Reception), Chestnut (Years One and Two), Willow (Years Three and Four) and Oak (Years Five and Six).

This position is to work with a child currently in Year Four and will involve working within the classroom alongside the wider teaching team but more frequently outside the classroom with this individual child on a one:one basis.

Some of the duties involved within this role are as follows:

- Developing a supportive relationship with the pupil and their parents
- Providing appropriate support to allow the pupil to access the curriculum
- Supporting more closely identified areas of personal weakness/need
- Liaising and working closely with the class team, contributing to IEPs, planning and delivery as needed
- Modifying or adapting learning activities in response informed by pupil or to provide an appropriate level of challenge
- Delivering specific support programmes/interventions, including phonics
- Supporting social skills both in and out of the classroom
- Working with small groups
- Providing feedback regarding pupil progress and recording levels of understanding as agreed with classteacher
- Clarifying and explaining instructions
- Supporting the use of equipment as necessary
- Creating or personalising bespoke resources to support the pupil
- Reading, understanding and applying school policies
- Establishing a positive and supportive relationship with parents, communicating regularly and respecting confidentiality

This is a representative list of required duties but is not exhaustive. Further details are clarified within the job description.
